You may place your order online or you may send the order in your child's bag along with a check written out to **Scholastic** and I can place your order and mail in your check. If you would like to order books, the order needs to be placed by September 10<sup>th</sup>. If you stick an order in your child's bag, please be sure to let them know as we don't always check bags every day. If you have questions on ordering please don't hesitate to ask!

**Songs** ~ During circle time we have been learning some new songs. If you would like to check these songs out with your child go to youtube.com and type in Who Let The Letters Out by Dr. Jean and Country Countdown by Dr. Jean. We also get our hugs in for the day by listening to Charlotte Diamonds 4 Hugs A Day song which can also be found on youtube.
