They finished off their exciting field trip by picking 4 apples from the apple trees. On Thursday, students completed a rhyming activity in which they had to glue two pictures on that rhymed with the given picture. They also cut out, glued, and colored a Dalmatian dog hat. Which of course turned out super cute! With the assessing that we still needed to get done, we did not get around to starting our writing curriculum. We are hoping to start that on Tuesday when we get back!
